Ahead of his time, he created a biomass product from waste in the 1930s, espoused cooperative space exploration between the U.S. and Russia during the Cold War, and created the Earth Flag -- "a flag that's just for people" -- as a symbol of global unity. And he conceived the original Earth Day on the spring equinox -- not April 22 -- just as Americans were beginning to wake up to pollution's dire impact. Into his 90s, John persisted in his cause through telephone and Internet communications, trusting in prayer that people would "come together where they agree while leaving room for their differences" in order to "continue the human adventure on Earth, our nest in the stars, with its wonderful web of life."
